

## Second Assembly Educateurs sans Frontières



Montessori pedagogical principles are rooted in a social movement intended to champion the cause of all children, in all strata of society, of all races and ethnic backgrounds, within and beyond educational institutions. The six-week Educateurs sans Frontières programme is intended to prepare holders of an AMI diploma at any age level to work in different fields as 'educators without borders'. Classroom experience is not required. Acceptance into the programme will be based on the applicants' life and work history, their rationale and their motivation.

The organisation of the second assembly of Educateurs sans Frontières—to be held in Spain, from July 12 until August 24, 2003—is now underway. An application form will be sent to those people interested, and will be followed up by

an interview as part of the admission procedure. Applicants who have changed their e-mail address since initially requesting information on the gathering and who have not received an application form are invited to contact the AMI Secretariat.

### FROM THE AMI BY-LAWS

By-law no. 17: 'Educateurs sans Frontières' is an AMI Programme in which the participants (AMI diploma holders) revisit the Montessori principles and practices from the perspective of society at large.
